Frameworks - what are they and why are they required?:

Under the Procurement Act 2023 (as amended), NHS Trusts are required to follow strict guidelines for public procurement to ensure **fairness, transparency, and value for money**. Frameworks are a key tool in meeting these requirements. A framework is a pre-negotiated contract that allows trusts to purchase goods or services from approved suppliers without going through a full tender process each time.

This helps trusts to;

- ✔ Save time.
- ✔ Reduce administrative burden.
- ✔ Provide access to competitive prices.
- ✔ Ensure access to high-quality products and services.

Using frameworks ensures **legal compliance** with the Procurement Act 2023 (as amended), which mandates that all public sector procurement must be fair and transparent. They also help NHS Trusts to avoid working with unvetted suppliers, reducing the risk of poor service delivery or non-compliance with agreed standards.

Without frameworks, trusts risk failing to meet these legal requirements, which could lead to;

- ✘ Legal challenges.
- ✘ Higher costs.
- ✘ Procurement delays.

Frameworks are essential for NHS Trusts to manage procurement efficiently, stay within legal guidelines and protect public funds.

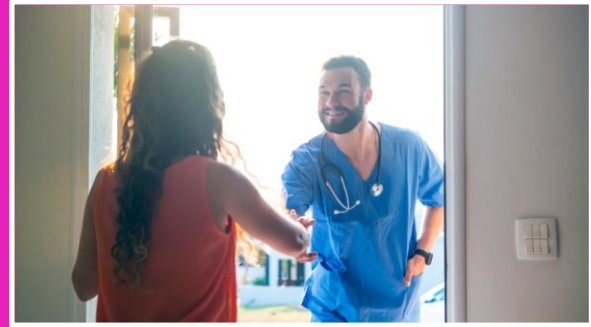
